- Graphite pencil HB, F, or H OR #2 mechanical pencil
- Kneaded Eraser
- Removable mounting putty (also known as poster putty or "sticky tac")
- **General's Factis BM-2 Mechanical Eraser** (preferred for its 1/8" diameter) OR **Staedtler Mars Plastic** Stick Eraser (about 1/4" diameter)
- 2-3 Paper blending stumps, any size also known as "stomps" or "tortillions"
- Basic scratchboard tool or Stencil knife or other small X-acto type knife with new (or lightly used) blade
- Small piece of sandpaper (any type will do)
- Single- or Double-ended embossing stylus (Pergamano is a good brand but Loew-Cornell makes an inexpensive version)
- Ballpoint pen
- Handheld or battery-operated pencil sharpener that gives a SHARP point
- Scotch tape
- Drafting brush
