### **Prismacolor Premier Pencils**

(Please sharpen in advance) Please bring all the colors you already have.

If you don't have a lot of colors, I highly recommend buying the tin box set of 48 colors. The pencils are usually cheaper by the set.

**Paper**: Stonehenge Printmaking Paper: White (22"x30") sheet cut into two sheets of 15x 22
